

15th Annual EVERETT COHO DERBY® & RAFFLE Rules

Derby Held: September, Saturday 20th and Sunday 21st, 2008

DERBY RULES:

All measured time will be determined by cell phone time.

1. Weigh-in will be from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm on Saturday, September the 20th and 10:00 am until 2:00 pm on Sunday, September the 21st, at the 10th Street Public Boat Launch, Everett WA. Deadlines for weigh-in shall be **FOLLOWED**. The individual who caught the fish must be present to enter the fish. The individual's legal Catch Record Card must accompany the individual and fish to be weighed in for evidence that a Coho Salmon was caught within Derby Rules. All persons in the boat must have a valid Derby Ticket. This is an all weather derby.
2. One entry fish per ticket purchaser. Additional adult tickets can be purchased for the Raffle Grand Prize. Coho Salmon entered on Saturday, September the 20th may be upgraded with a fish caught on Sunday, September the 21st. If you catch a larger fish, please tell the attendant on Sunday, September the 21st you wish to upgrade and have your ticket present.
3. Ticket sales will close on Friday, September the 19th at 9:00 pm at all retail outlets. Tickets will be available Saturday the 20th, at the 10th St. Public Boat Launch from 4:00 am to 8:00 am. After 8:00 am, Saturday, September the 20th & Sunday, September the 21st until 2:00 pm, only tickets for the Raffle Grand Prize will be sold.
4. Minimum size of fish entered shall be greater than two (2) pounds. If in the opinion of the judges, any attempt is made to artificially enhance the weight of a fish, that fish and person WILL be immediately disqualified from this and all future Everett Coho Derby's and criminal charges WILL be pursued.
5. Proof of purchase will be required for any prizes linked to a special prize.
6. Ties will be broken by the earliest date and time of entry.
7. Youth Division – 12 years or younger will receive 1st \$100.00, 2nd \$75.00, and 3rd \$50.00. Ticket is free.
8. ALL WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE RULES APPLY. Including all legal areas open to fishing in area's 8-1; 8-2; 9; 10; the Stillaguamish system; the Snohomish system; and Skagit system. Only legally hooked Coho Salmon are eligible to win. (Must be sport caught).
9. The Everett Steelhead and Salmon Club, Snohomish Sportsmen's Club, or their sponsors, accept no responsibility for loss, damage, injury to any boat, vehicle, equipment, contestant, passenger or observer during this event. The Derby ticket purchaser agrees to hold harmless all Derby presenters and sponsors from any and all liability in connection with this Derby.
10. The ticket purchaser agrees that any appropriate prize taxes, as use or sales taxes, and fees, as transfer or operating fees, shall be the sole responsibility of the prizewinner, and that the afore mentioned derby organizations shall have no liability for any such taxes or fees. Prizewinners shall also furnish their tax identification number upon request before the awarding of prizes.

TAGGED FISH RULES:

1. ***** YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN! *****
2. Prior to Derby Day, Ten (10) Legal Coho Salmon will be tagged and released in Derby Waters.
3. Tagged fish must be registered at Derby weigh-in by 2:00 pm on Sunday, September the 21st (see rule 1)
4. Tagged fish prizes are \$25,000, \$2500, \$1000 and Seven (7) - \$500 prizes to be announced at awards ceremony.

RAFFLE RULES:

1. ***** YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN! *****
2. Raffle Grand Prizewinner solely responsible for taxes and fees per rule 11 above. If a minor wins the Raffle Grand Prize or cash, with the purchase of an adult ticket, the cash or Grand Prize shall be awarded in the name of the parent or guardian.
3. Adult ticket purchaser does not have to fish to be eligible only for the Raffle Grand Prize.
4. Prizes will be awarded Sunday, September 21st, beginning at 3:00 pm at the 10th Street Public Boat Launch, 10th and Marine View Drive, Everett. RAFFLE GRAND PRIZE WILL BE DRAWN on or about 4:30 pm.
