

16th Annual EVERETT COHO DERBY & RAFFLE Rules

Derby Held: September, Saturday 19th and Sunday 20th, 2009

DERBY RULES:

All measured time will be determined by cell phone time.

1. Weigh-in will be from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm on Saturday, September the 19th and 10:00 am until 2:00 pm on Sunday, September the 20th, at the 10th Street Public Boat Launch, off of Marine view Drive, Everett. Derby participant must be in the official weigh-in line (queue) by close of weigh-in time each day. The individual who caught the fish must be present to enter the fish. The individual's legal Catch Record Card must accompany the individual and fish to be weighted in for evidence that a Coho Salmon was caught within Derby Rules. All persons fishing from a boat must have a valid Derby Ticket. This is an all weather derby.
2. One entry fish per ticket purchaser. Additional adult tickets can be purchased for the Raffle Grand Prize. Coho Salmon entered on Saturday, September the 19th may be upgraded with a fish caught on Sunday, September the 20th. If you catch a larger fish, please tell the attendant on Sunday, September the 20th you wish to upgrade and have your ticket present.
3. Ticket sales will close on Friday, September the 18th at 9:00 pm at all retail outlets. **Tickets will be available Saturday the 19th, at the 10th St. Public Boat Ramp from 4:00 am to 8:00 am. After 8:00 am, Saturday, September the 19th & Sunday, September the 20th until 2:00 pm, only tickets for the Raffle Grand Prize will be sold.**
4. Minimum size of fish entered shall be greater than two (2) pounds. **If in the opinion of the judges, any attempt is made to artificially enhance the weight of a fish, that fish and person WILL be immediately disqualified from this and all future Everett Coho Derby's and criminal charges WILL be pursued.**
5. Proof of purchase will be required for any prizes linked to a special prize.
6. Ties will be broken by the earliest date and time of entry.
7. Youth Division – 12 years or younger will receive 1st \$100.00, 2nd \$75.00, and 3rd \$50.00. Ticket is free.
8. **ALL WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE RULES APPLY.** Including all legal areas open to fishing in area's 8-1; 8-2; 9; 10; and all fresh water systems in King, Skagit or Snohomish County. Only legally hooked Coho Salmon are eligible to win.
9. The Everett Steelhead and Salmon Club, Snohomish Sportsmen's Club, or their sponsors, accept no responsibility for loss, damage, injury to any boat, vehicle, equipment, contestant, passenger or observer during this event. The Derby ticket purchaser agrees to hold harmless all Derby presenters and sponsors from any and all liability in connection with this Derby.
10. The ticket purchaser agrees that any appropriate prize taxes, as use or sales taxes, and fees, as transfer or operating fees, shall be the sole responsibility of the prize winner, and that the afore mentioned derby organizations shall have no liability for any such taxes or fees. Prizewinners shall also furnish their tax identification number upon request before the awarding of prizes.
11. **Prizes will be awarded Sunday, September 20th, beginning at 3:00 pm at Everett Bayside Marine and Outboard, 1111 Craftsman Way, Everett, WA . RAFFLE GRAND PRIZE WILL BE DRAWN on or about 4:30 pm.**

MYSTERY FISH WEIGHT:

13. The Mystery Fish opportunity will be the 6th, 25th, 75th, 100th and last place fish entered. SCA Promotions will select the 5 mystery weights numbers from point ".00" to ".99", and seal them in 5 security envelopes marked to correspond with the above five places. Each envelope will have a number from .00-.99. If the two numbers to the immediate right of the decimal of the selected "place" fish exactly matches the two numbers of the entered fish, they will receive the \$25,000 prize. For example, if the 6th place fish weighs 15.05 pounds and the envelope contains the number .05, that fish will win the prize & any other number will not win. This will continue to the 25th, 75th, 100th and last place fish utilizing the number in their respective envelopes as needed
14. There will be five chances to win and the first winner ends the contest.

RAFFLE:

15. Raffle Grand Prizewinner solely responsible for taxes and fees per rule 10 above. If a minor wins the Raffle Grand Prize or cash, with the purchase of an adult ticket, the cash or Grand Prize shall be awarded in the name of the parent or guardian.
